

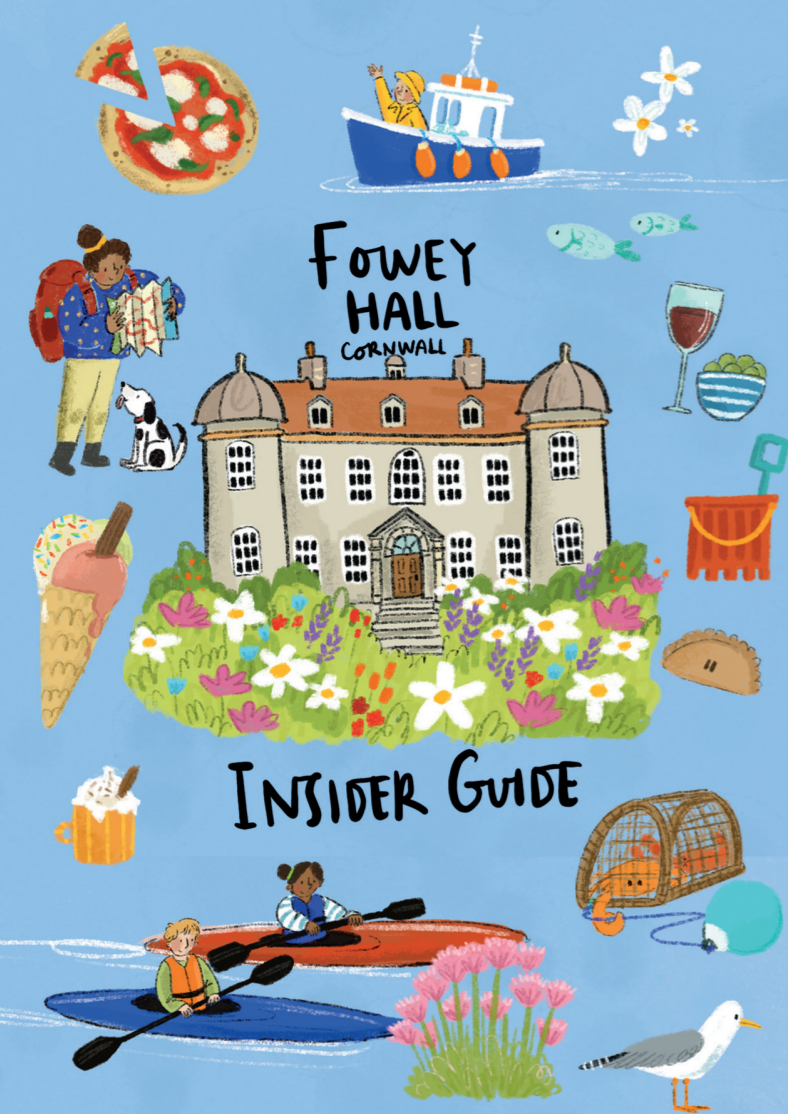

Lerryn

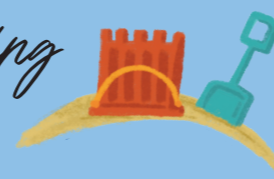
Polkerris Beach

Fowey Aquarium

Beaches

Readymoney Cove

This is within walking distance but there is also a small car park at the top of the hill, which is useful if you have small children and lots to carry! The coffee shop has lovely local ice cream.

🐾 Sept - Jun

Polkerris

Jump in your car and head out of Fowey towards St Austell – there is a large car park about 300m from the beach. Polkerris is the best serviced beach with a pub, restaurant and shops as well as kayak and paddleboard hire!

Lantic Bay Beach

To get to Lantic Bay, you'll need to take the Bodinnick car ferry. On the other side, follow the signs to Polruan until you get to the Latic Bay National Trust car park. It's a very steep 15-minute walk down to the beach but it's well worth it!

🐾 All year round

Porthluney

Porthluney is about 40 minutes away but well worth the journey and there is a large car park right next to the beach. Unlike many others, Porthluney is very flat so great for small kids as the water doesn't go too deep too soon!

Walking

Walk into Fowey

🚶 2.5km

Walk down the hill to the main town quay, then along the esplanade to Readymoney Cove. From there, head back up the hill (Tower Park and Gallants Drive) and back along Hanson Drive to the hotel.

Walk to Menabbly

🚶 8km

Walk down to Readymoney Cove and continue along the coastal path to St Catherine Castle. Follow the path until you go down some steps and get to a very lonely house on the beach. Take the first set of steps away from the beach up the hill and follow the path until you reach the National Trust car park. From there, follow the footpath signs back to Fowey.

Walk to Lantic Bay

🚶 8km

Walk down the hill to the town Quay or at low tide walk to Whitehouse Quay, then take the ferry (which leaves every 15 minutes). Once at Polruan, walk up a few steps then along West Street to Polruan Castle. This is a perfect photo opportunity! Next, walk up Battery Lane and continue along the coastal path until you reach the path down to Lantic Bay. The path down to the beach is steep, but well worth it. Complete the walk by getting the passenger ferry back to Fowey.

Walk to Polkerris

🚶 9km

Walk down to Readymoney Cove and continue along the coastal path to St Catherine Castle. Follow the path until you go down some steps and get to a very lonely house on the beach. Keep following the coastal path until you reach the Gribbon Head lighthouse. From there, follow the signs to Polkerris, where you can have a drink at The Rashleigh, before calling a taxi to bring you back.



South West Coastal Path

Enjoy some time on the South West Coastal Path, there are 3 routes you can join just a short walk from the hotel.
