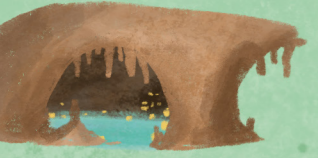

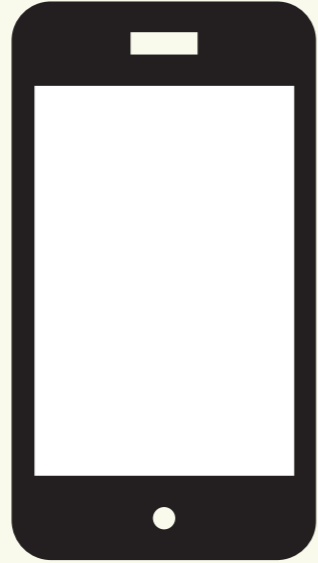

Walks

National Trust Skyline Walk

National Trust Skyline Walk in Bath offers a breathtaking blend of natural beauty, historical landmarks, and family-friendly activities. This 6-mile (10 km) circular walk takes you through stunning landscapes with panoramic views of Bath and its surrounding countryside. It's a fantastic way to experience the outdoors while exploring the heritage of this beautiful city.

Walk to Westbury White Horse

One of the 13 white horses of Wiltshire (8 still visible). Reputedly the oldest in Wiltshire, being about 300 years old.

Heaven's Gate Walk

The Heaven's Gate Walk near Warminster is a delightful nature walk that offers scenic views and historic landmarks, and a pleasant outdoor experience for families and dogs. This 2.5-mile circular walk is suitable for all ages and provides a great way to explore the beautiful countryside around Bath.

Prehistoric monument, approximately 4,000 years old on Salisbury Plain, 2 miles west of Amesbury.

Bristol Zoo

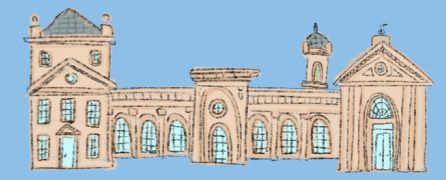
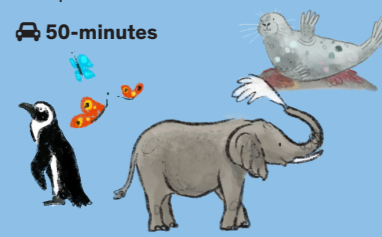
Discover animals from across the world, from the mischievous lemurs of Madagascar to magnificent European brown bears.

Day Exploring

Longleat Safari Park

Start your day with a visit to Longleat, a fantastic family-friendly destination perfect for creating lasting memories. Begin with the thrilling Safari Drive, where you can get up close with majestic lions, playful monkeys, and other incredible wildlife from the comfort of your car. Half Day Exploring

Explore Lacock

Drive to Lacock, a 14th century village about 20 minutes away and park in the National Trust car park. Explore the village (pushchair and dog friendly) which has been used for many film sets and includes charming independently owned shops and a play area. Visit Lacock Abbey (assistance dogs only) where parts of Harry Potter Philosophers Stone and Chamber of Secrets were filmed and immerse yourself in the rich history of the Abbey.

If visiting with a dog, we recommend a walk through the village and fields behind the Abbey.

We recommend hot chocolate or milkshake from Coco Chemistry; shop is located only short walk away from the Abbey.

Drive back to the hotel and after lunch, enjoy an afternoon around the swimming pool and Walled Garden.

Discover Frome

Explore the charm of Frome, a vibrant market town with cobbled streets, independent shops, and a thriving arts scene. Explore its historic architecture, enjoy unique boutiques, and enjoy a bite to eat in one of the local cafes.

Half Day Exploring

Fairfield Animal Centre

A fun family day out, set in 15 acres of Southwick Country Park near Trowbridge. Come and see a variety of animals including goats, sheep, pigs, donkeys and much more.

Explore Bradford-on-Avon

Discover the charming streets, explore historic architecture, wander along the scenic canal, and visit the Tithe Barn. Enjoy quaint cafes, boutique shops, and walk along the River Avon and then the Kennet and Avon Canal.

Day Exploring

Visit Bath

Start the day with a gentle stroll to Bradford-on-Avon train station and take a 10-minutes train ride to Bath City centre.

We recommend Victoria Falls Adventure Golf and children's playground at the bottom of Victoria Park.

For lunch we recommend: Scallop Shell for fish and chips, Dough for sour dough pizza, or if you are looking for something more adventurous Noya's kitchen offers authentic Vietnamese cuisine. If you are visiting Bath with your four-legged friend, we recommend The Marlborough Tavern near The Royal Crescent.
